



Genesis 3:1-8




God gives Do's and Don'ts to Humanity

Lucifer adds doubt to what God said to deceive a window shopping Eve, which eventually led to Adam choosing Eve over God. - Genesis 3:1-6




Disobedience to God is Sin

Satan tried to deceive Jesus to sin, so he tempts him but to no avail

The life of Jesus is an example for all human beings – with 3 temptations Satan tested Jesus: but Jesus did not succumb to Satan's temptations. -Matthew 4:1-11.



The 1st Temptation of Jesus

1. Stones into bread — this is Hedonism (hunger / satisfaction) — which is "lust of the flesh". — 1 John 2:16.

This is an attack on the Bible - Table of Shew Bread in the Holy Place of the Sanctuary.

Attack of Jesus as - High Priest in heaven.



The 2nd Temptation of Jesus

2. Jump from the Temple – This is Egoism (spectacular throw / might) – which is the "pride of life" – 1 John 2:16.

This is an attack on Prover Alter of

Prayer - Alter of Incense in the Holy Place of Sanctuary.
Attack of Jesus as - High Priest in heaven.



The 3rd Temptation of Jesus

3. Kingdoms of the World – this is Materialism (kingdoms / wealth) – which is "lust of eyes" – 1 John 2:16.

This is an attack on Witnessing - 7 Branch Candlesticks in the holy place of the Sanctuary.
Attack of Jesus as - High Priest in heaven.



Jesus admonishes all age groups of these 3 Temptations...

On these three umbrella points all humanity would be tempted by Satan as well.

The Bible therefore addresses 3 groups:

- 1. Little children
- 2. Young People
- 3. Adults / Parents
 Admonishing all to refrain from these temptations
- 1 John 2:12-17.

The lust of the flesh
The lust of the eyes
And the pride of life

is not from the Father, but is from the world.

1 John 2:16



1. <u>His Parents: A Shadow of Illegitimacy</u>

Since Mary and Joseph were not married when Mary conceived Christ by the Holy Spirit, others assumed that Jesus' birth was the result of fornication. Joseph prepared to terminate their betrothal until an angel came to him and confirmed Mary's integrity. (See Matthew 1:18-25.)



2. <u>His Time in History: A Wicked</u> Ruler

When King Herod learned that a king of the Jews had been born, he gave an order to kill all Jewish boys aged two years old and younger in the vicinity of Bethlehem. (See Matthew 2:16.)

As Jesus grew to an age of understanding, He would likely have known of the many families who lost male children because of His birth.



3. His Race: A Despised People

Surrounding nations hated the Israelites and took opportunities to plunder and oppress the Jewish people. The Romans dominated Israel in Jesus' day (see John 11:47–48), and historically, since the calling of Abraham to be the father of God's chosen people, the people of Gentile nations around Israel envied, warred against, and competed with the Jews.




4. <u>His Nation: A</u> Conquered Land

Jesus grew up in a land that had been conquered by Rome and was occupied by Roman soldiers. Ultimately, it was the Romans who crucified Him. (See Luke 2:1–3 and John 18:28-19:30.)



5. <u>His Gender: A Predetermined</u> **Vocation**

In the time when Jesus was on earth, sons were trained in the vocation of their fathers. Jesus was expected to labour in His earthly father's trade until He was thirty years old. Consequently, when Jesus began His ministry, He was not known as the Son of God but rather as "the carpenter's son." - Luke 3:23; Matthew 13:55.




6. <u>His Birth Order: A Lifetime</u> Responsibility

Jesus was the firstborn son and, as such, was responsible to care for the family if anything happened to His father. During Christ's youth, His earthly father, Joseph, did die. Thereafter, Jesus assumed the continuing care of His widowed mother. Christ fulfilled this responsibility until His death, when He transferred Mary's care to His disciple, John. - John 19:26-27.




7. His Family: A Prophet without Honor

People are often misunderstood or rejected by their own family members. Christ experienced this challenge during His ministry as well. His friends accused Him of being insane, and His mother and brothers came to His place of preaching to take Him home. (See Mark 3:21-22, 3:31-32.) His brothers' actions demonstrated their unbelief. (See John 7:5.)



8. <u>His Appearance: A Lack of</u> **Beauty**

We do not have a detailed description of Christ's physical appearance during His earthly ministry, but from Isaiah's prophecy, we learn that He did not possess any special physical attractiveness. "He hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him" (Isaiah 53:2)




9. <u>His Divine Nature: An</u> **Offense to Friends**

When Jesus stood up in the synagogue of His hometown and declared Who He was and what He had come to do, His own friends and neighbours were so offended that they wanted to kill Him. (See Luke 4:16-30.)



10. His Death: A Public Shame

The time and circumstances of Jesus' death were chosen for Him. Crucifixion was the most painful and ruthless form of execution devised by man. (See Galatians 3:13.) It was a sentence reserved for the worst offenders.




Jesus's life is exemplary for all humanity

Unchangeable features such as family, ethnicity, and time in history have a great influence in our lives.

But Jesus Christ experienced the same defining features in His life.

Scripture assures us that Jesus can sympathize with our struggles because He was tested in the same areas in which we are tested. (See Hebrews 4:15–16.)

The specific circumstances of Jesus' life fulfilled Biblical prophecy and qualified Him to complete His redemptive mission.



The 3G's: Last lap of Jesus on Earth

Today we live in a world of 5G technology.

However, I want to take you back to ancient 3G's.

- 1. Gethsemane Matthew 26:36-56
- 2. Gabbatha Matthew 26:36-56
- 3. Golgotha Matthew 27:24-54



Origin of punishment of death by Crucifixion

Crucifixion was invented by the Persians in 479 B.C. and perfected by the Romans in 100 B.C.

It is quite possibly the most painful death ever invented by humankind.

The English language derives the word "excruciating" from crucifixion, acknowledging it as a form of slow, painful suffering.

Its punishment was reserved for slaves, foreigners, revolutionaries, and the vilest of criminals. See Matthew 27:33-56, Mark 15:22-41, Luke 23:27-49, John 19:17-37







The 1st "G" is Gethsemane

After the Passover celebration, Jesus takes His disciples to Gethsemane to pray.

He then took with him Peter James & John further, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy.

He tells them to watch and pray, that they enter not into temptation and goes further to pray.

Three times He comes to them and they are found sleeping.

See Matthew 26:36-46, Mark 14:37-42, Luke 22:39-44



Jesus sufferings at Gethsemane - 1st "G"

During His anxious prayer about the events to come, Jesus sweats drops of blood.

There is a rare medical condition called hematohidrosis, during which the capillary blood vessels that feed the sweat glands break down.

Blood released from the vessels mixes with the sweat; therefore, the body sweats drops of blood.

This condition results from mental anguish or high anxiety, a state Jesus expresses by praying "my soul is deeply grieved to the point of death" (Matthew 26:38).

 Hematohidrosis makes the skin tender, so Jesus' physical condition worsens slightly.



The 2nd "G" is Gabbatha – The Pavement

Traveling from Pilate to Herod and back again, Jesus walks approximately two and a half miles. He has not slept, and He has been mocked and beaten (Luke 22:63-65). In addition, His skin remains tender from the hematohidrosis. His physical condition worsens. See Matthew 26:67-75, Mark 14:61-72, Luke 22:54-23:25, John 18:16-27




Jesus beaten with Roman Whip - 2nd "G"

Pilate orders Jesus to be flogged as required by Roman law before crucifixion Traditionally, the accused stood naked, and the flogging covered the area from the shoulders down to the upper legs.

The whip consisted of several strips of leather. In the middle of the strips were metal balls that hit the skin, causing deep bruising. In addition, sheep bone was attached to the tips of each strip.

When the bone makes contact with Jesus' skin, it digs into His muscles, tearing out chunks of flesh and exposing the bone beneath.



Crown of thorns pushed on His head - 2nd "G"

Roman soldiers place a crown of thorns on Jesus' head and a robe on His back (Matthew 27:28-29). The robe helps the stop bleeding to prevent from sustaining more blood loss.

As they hit Jesus in the head (Matthew 27:30), the thorns from the crown push into the skin and He begins bleeding profusely.

The thorns also cause damage to the nerve that supplies the face, causing intense pain down His face and neck.



They cast lots to take Jesus clothes - 2nd "G"

As they mock Him, the soldiers also belittle Jesus by spitting on Him (Matthew 27:30).

They rip the robe off Jesus' back and the bleeding starts afresh.

His clothing was divided by the Roman guards by lots (Matthew 27:28-30).

This was in fulfilment of the prophecy in Psalm 22:18.



The 3rd "G" is Golgotha

It is important to understand from the beginning that Jesus would have been in excellent physical condition.


As a carpenter by trade, He participated in physical labour. In addition, He spent much of His ministry traveling on foot across the countryside. His stamina and strength were, most likely, very well developed.

With that in mind, it is clear just how much He suffered: If this torture could break a man in such good shape, it must have been a horrific experience especially on the cross.




The Plan of Redemption of Humanity – 3rd "G"

Jesus wounded in six places representing six articles of the Sanctuary = Symbol of CROSS.



Jesus Wounded


- 1. Nail in His Feet (Psalm 22:16).
- 2. Pierced Side: Blood and Water (John 19:34).
- 3. Nail in the Left Hand.
- 4. Died from a Broken Heart: (Matthew 27:46).
- **5.** Nail in the Right Hand.
- 6. Crown of Thorns: (Matthew 27:29).



Agony Jesus endured on the Cross - 3rd "G"

Both of His feet were nailed together. Thus, He was forced to support Himself on the single nail that impaled His feet to the cross. Jesus could not support himself with His legs because of the pain.

So, He was forced to alternate between arching His back then using his legs just to continue to breathe. Imagine the struggle, the pain, the suffering, the courage.




Agony Jesus endured on the Cross – 3rd "G" (cont'd)

The accused needed to be nailed to the cross while lying down, so Jesus is thrown to the ground, reopening His wounds, grinding in dirt, and causing bleeding. They nail His "hands" to the patibulum.

The Greek meaning of "hands" includes the wrist.

It is more likely that the nails went through Jesus' wrists.

If the nails were driven into the hand, the weight of the arms would cause the nail to rip through the soft flesh.




Agony Jesus endured on the Cross – 3rd "G" (cont'd)

Normally, to breathe in, the diaphragm (the large muscle that separates the chest cavity from the abdominal cavity) must move down.

This enlarges the chest cavity and air automatically moves into the lungs (inhalation). To exhale, the diaphragm rises up, which compresses the air in the lungs and forces the air out (exhalation).

As Jesus hangs on the cross, the weight of His body pulls down on the diaphragm and the air moves into His lungs and remains there. Jesus must push up on His nailed feet (causing more pain) to exhale.




Agony Jesus endured on the Cross – 3rd "G" (cont'd)

The difficulty surrounding exhalation leads to a slow form of suffocation. Carbon dioxide builds up in the blood, resulting in a high level of carbonic acid in the blood. The body responds instinctively, triggering the desire to breathe.

At the same time, the heart beats faster to circulate available oxygen. The decreased oxygen causes damage to the tissues and the capillaries begin leaking watery fluid from the blood into the tissues.

This results in a build-up of fluid around the heart (pericardial effusion) and lungs (pleural effusion). The collapsing lungs, failing heart, dehydration, and the inability to get sufficient oxygen to the tissues essentially suffocates.




Agony Jesus endured on the Cross – 3rd "G" (cont'd)

After Jesus' death, the soldiers break the legs of the two criminals crucified alongside Him (John 19:32), causing suffocation. Death would then occur quicker.


When they came to Jesus, He was already dead so they did not break His legs (John 19:33). Instead, the soldiers pierced His side (John 19:34) to assure that He was dead.

In doing this, it is reported that "blood and water came out" (John 19:34), referring to the watery fluid surrounding the heart and lungs.




Our Path







- First, there is no biblical evidence for a SEVEN-YEAR period of TRIBULATION following Jesus' return to Earth.

- The Bible is clear that when Jesus returns, every person's eternal fate has been decided; individuals who are lost will not have a second CHANCE TO BE SAVED.





So then what is Historicism?

HISTORICISM

Historicism sees these prophecies as having a direct application to Papal Rome as a system whose doctrines are actually a denial of the New Testament message of free salvation by grace through simple faith in Jesus Christ, apart from works. Historicism was the primary prophetic viewpoint of the Protestant Reformers


PROPHECY





During the 7 Years of Tribulation: the Seals, Trumpets and Bowls happen!








This was done not so much only to hide the Papacy as anti-christ, but to confuse the Protestants!

Of the 2300 years prophecy God gives 490 years to the Jews specifically!







Jesus right now is on his throne in Judgement




