



- 1. Digestive Health: relieves indigestion and bloating.
- 2. Blood Sugar Regulation: glucosinolate and isothiocyanate, manage blood sugar levels. and improve insulin sensitivity.
- 3. They have Antioxidant and Anti-inflammatory Properties.
- 4. Cancer Prevention: has sulforaphane, which may help prevent the formation of cancerous cells and tumours.
- 5. Aid in liver detoxification by triggering enzymes that help eliminate toxins and protect against liver damage.

Jesus - 2nd Adam, his side was opened and his bride comes forth - 1 Corinthians 15:45 & John 19:34.






Noah – was lifted up above the earth and all men were drawn unto him - Genesis 7:17-18.

Isaac – was given up as a sacrifice by the father - Genesis 22:2-13.




Jesus – was given up as a sacrifice by the father - Romans 8:32.

• Esau sold his birth-right for food to his twin - Genesis 25:29-34.




Jesus - 2nd Adam gained his birthright over 1st Adam - Romans 5:12-21

 Adam too sold his birth-right for food - 1 Corinthians 15:22.




Part 1 – Jesus in the life of Joseph

1. **Joseph** – betrayed by his own, sold for 20 pieces of silver - Genesis 37:28.




Jesus – betrayed by his own (Judas & Pharisees), sold for 30 pieces of silver - Matthew 26:14-16.



2. Joseph is sent ahead to prepare a place for his brothers - Genesis 45:4-8.



Jesus is sent ahead to prepare a place for his brothers - John 14:2-3.




- 3. Joseph is put in prison for a crime he did not commit Genesis 39:19-20.
- Even though Potiphar knew he did not commit that crime.




Jesus is condemned to death - Matthew 27:11-26.

4. Joseph ended up between a butler and a baker, at the end one is restored and other lost - Genesis 40.

Jesus ended up between two thieves, at the end one is saved and the other is lost - Luke 23:32-43.






5. Joseph ascended to be the right-hand man of Pharaoh - Genesis 41:42-44.

6. The 11 brothers come to Joseph but do not recognise him - Genesis 42:8.




When Jesus came to this earth his own did not recognise Him - John 1:11.



7. Joseph investigates his brothers when they are searching for food - Genesis 42:7.




Jesus is investigating in judgement right now while men are searching for food - Matthew 25:31-46.







8. Joseph examines if they are changed and how they treat one another - Genesis 42:21-22.

9. Joseph - do they love the least/youngest of all Benjamin - Genesis 44.



Jesus is checking do they love the least of them? (You doeth unto me - Matthew 25:40)



10. When Joseph sees they have truly changed he says come and sup with me - Genesis 45:17-20.

Jesus invites all who do the fathers commandments to come and sup with him in His kingdom – Revelation 22:14.





11. Joseph gives the last brother special privilege - Genesis 43:34.

Jesus gives the 144,000 special privilege - Revelation 14:1-5.

- Rachel gives Bilhah to Jacob, who bore (5) Dan and (6) Naphtali.
- Leah gives Zilpah to Jacob, she bore him (7) Gad and (8) Asher.
- Leah conceived (twice) again (9) Issachar and (10) Zebulun.
- Rachel gave birth to (11) Joseph and (12) Benjamin as she died.

- Joseph had to walk through the experience of Jesus
- Joseph also walks in the path of the last day remnant – SDA's


Remnant have other brothers (45,000 plus denominations according to the Centre for the Study of Global Christianity) of different mothers but same father.

Other denominations existed from long-time, Seventh-day Adventists come along on 21st May 1863.




3. The 11 don't like Joseph because he keeps his father's commandments.

And in those days the children will begin to study the laws, And to seek the commandments, And return to the path of righteousness.






4. They hate him because he has the spirit of prophecy.

6. The 11 are seeking to get rid of Joseph and see how his prophecies will come to pass.




Remnant (Seventh-day Adventists) too will be wanted to get rid of because of the prophetic message.



7. The 11 say you are not one of us and put him in a pit.




Remnant will be put in isolation because of 7th day Sabbath.






8. The 11 sell Joseph into slavery without freedom.

Remnant have to overcome the harlot (Babylon – Papal system of Revelation 17)




10. Pharaoh has a dream and calls for Joseph to interpret it.




Remnant will be called before authorities to interpret why and what they believe.




11. The interpretation is to gather bread in time of plenty for the time of famine.

Remnant put in charge of gathering bread by the Father for the time of famine/trouble.



Part 2 - Remnant in the life of Joseph (Conclusion)

- Brothers from other mothers are coming, be ready to feed them!
- How many of us are gathering bread today for the time of famine?
- When someone asks a question, do we have an answer?

Part 3 – Joseph in Egypt & End-time Scenario

Joseph now elevated to the 2nd in command (Genesis 41:39-41).

Joseph over a 14-year year time span, he planned to balance production and consumption rates using a long-term Sales Operation Planning (SOP), so that the supply chain would perform continuously and demand would be satisfied without stock-outs. - Genesis 41:33-36

Thus, the basic tenant of economic order quantity came into being – SOP.

If Joseph failed in fulfilling his duties

he would be executed.

• Right now, the powers are gathering up the support systems.









































The 7 years of Famine

2. The famine began in all the lands (Genesis 41:54), on the face of earth (Genesis 41:56)

• Inflation is going up, Interests and going up, Money is running low, etc...







3. All countries came to buy corn from Egypt to Joseph (Genesis 41:57).



• All will eventually have to subscribe to some extent on the reset system.



4. Pharaoh becomes richer and richer: Genesis 47:14 And Joseph gathered up all the money that was found in the land of Egypt, and in the land of Canaan, for the corn which they bought: and Joseph brought the money into Pharaoh's house.




 The rich get richer and the poor get poorer.




5. Then money failed in all the land: Genesis 47:15 And when money failed in the land of Egypt, and in the land of Canaan, all the Egyptians came unto Joseph, and said, Give us bread: for why should we die in thy presence? for the money faileth.



• The economy crashes eventually and people will be on benefits.



6. Aggression used in taking over the cattle of citizens: Genesis 47:16 And Joseph said, Give your cattle; and I will give you for your cattle, if money fail.



• Laws of forceful obedience to get the benefits.



7. Land or properties taken over in exchange for food: Genesis 47:20 And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so, the land became Pharaoh's.



• Properties will be confiscated.



8. People removed and moved into cities all over Egypt: Genesis 47:21 And as for the people, he removed them to cities from one end of the borders of Egypt even to the other end thereof.




 You own nothing and are only residing where you are designated to.




9. Finally, Citizens are bought too as slaves: Genesis 47:23 Then Joseph said unto the people, Behold, I have bought you this day and your land for Pharaoh: lo, here is seed for you, and ye shall sow the land.




 Now then, forced to go against conscience and follow the law of the land.



10. Exorbitant 1/5th or 20% taxing system is enforced by law: (Genesis 47:26) And Joseph made it a law over the land of Egypt unto this day, that Pharaoh should have the fifth part; except the land of the priests only, which became not Pharaoh's.




