


Health Benefits of Rice beans (Seek Medical Advice)

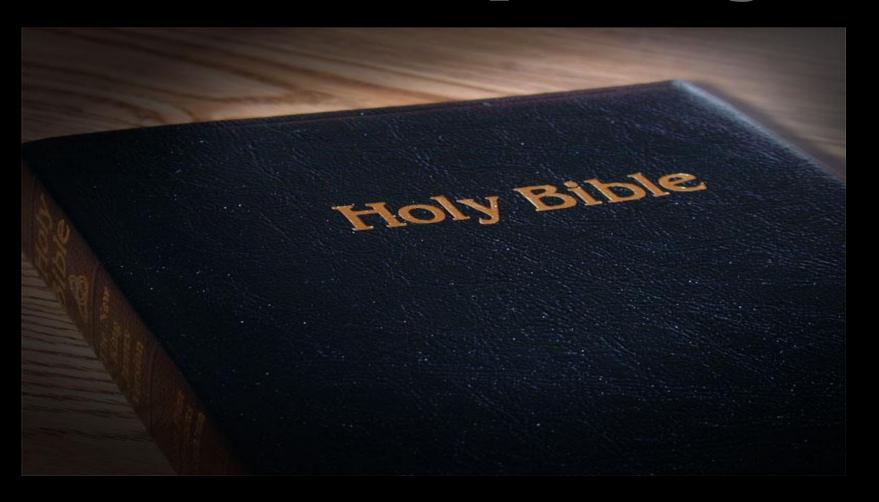
Health Benefits of Rice beans:

- 3. Has antioxidants that protect body against cell damage caused by free radicals, reducing the risk of chronic diseases.
- 4. Has iron & phosphorus, crucial for many bodily functions.
- 5. <u>Blood Sugar Control</u>: help suppress blood glucose by inhibiting alpha-glucosidase, beneficial for diabetics.
- 6. Have diuretic properties aiding in fluid balance in the body
- 7. Promote satiety, which aid in weight management efforts.
- 8. Possess anti-inflammatory properties, which can be helpful in managing inflammation-related conditions.




Introduction

The book of Exodus details the Israelites' liberation from slavery in Egypt and their journey to Mount Sinai, where they receive the Law and enter into a covenant with God.


Key themes include liberation, covenant, divine presence, and the establishment of Israel as a nation.

Jesus, came up out of Egypt to redeem the world. - Matthew 2:15










Part 3 – Remnant's Heavenward Journey Type and Antitype - 1 Corinthians 10:1-11

The Ten Plagues of Egypt




Remnant are brought out after the wrath of God of the 7 last plaques on Babylon. – Revelation 16

Remnant are raised up 21st May 1863 and the 1st vision given through Ellen White was health reform – 5th June 1863.




7. Israelites were to be a peculiar people, holy nation of priests. –

generation, royal priesthood, holy nation, peculiar people. – 1 Peter 2:9 Exodus 19:5-6



10. Israelites in serving the Egyptians were actually serving and worshiping the beast or dragon. - Ezekiel 29:2,3.



13. Israelites with their own eyes saw the destruction of their enemies at the Red Sea. - Exodus 14:30


Remnant will see the destruction of their enemies at the 2nd coming of Jesus. - Revelation 19:11-21






14. Israelites exodus movement was purged by the shaking out of the rebels who made this mixed multitude. - Ezekiel 20:35-38.


Remnant movement will be cleansed and purified in the same way: —by the shaking out of the mixed multitude. - Matthew 13:36-43

Remnant today are lusting after flesh foods, instead of going back to Edenic diet Genesis 1:29.

On earth, are clean:

The beasts that both chew the cud and have cloven hooves, like ox, sheep, goat, deer,

gazelle, roe deer, antelope, wild goat, mountain sheep.



In water, are clean:

All that have both fins and scales: thus, most kinds of fish are clean.

In the air, are clean:

The birds that are not considered as scavengers and are not found in the list of unclean birds. For example, chicken, turkey, and quail are clean.







17. Israelites between the Mount of the Law and Kadesh-Barnea ancient Israel passed through a dreadful wilderness. – Deuteronomy 8:15




Remnant also between 1844 and 1888 the Advent Movement passed through a dreadful spiritual wilderness. – Revelation 10:1-10



18. Israelites, just at Kadesh-Barnea brought their greatest crisis of their journey. — Deuteronomy 1:19





Remnant, the message of 1888 brought to our parting of the ways and the greatest crisis of SDA history (rejected Justification by Faith).

Remnant, God has sent to His people testimonies of truth and righteousness, it will be criticised and those that stand will be condemned. - Matthew 5:10-12





Remnant did not accept Righteousness by faith in 1888 and so faith in the coming of Jesus is weakened, therefore delay in proclaiming 3 AM's and may receive the Mark of the Beast in the right hand and lose eternal life all together.






