Introduction

The Book of Joshua records Israel's history from Moses's death to the time of the Judges. It is the first of twelve historical books of the Old Testament. In Numbers, we saw the Israelites fail because of unbelief. In contrast, in Joshua, the Israelites see victory due to their faith.

Joshua succeeded in leading the Israelites into the Promised Land aided by a miracle-working God. God parted the Jordan River so the Israelites could cross on dry land. So, as the Exodus had begun with a miracle, it also ended with a miracle (Joshua 3:14-17). In contrast, where Moses failed to lead the Israelites into the Promised Land due to their unbelief, Joshua succeeded because of their faith.




Introduction (cont'd)

The Israelites, led by Joshua, overcame their enemies and occupied the Promised Land. God, throughout the book of Joshua, shows the Israelites their victory before they receive it (Joshua 6:2, Joshua 8:1, Joshua 10:8). When they believed and obeyed God, they defeated their enemies. But when they didn't believe and obey God, they suffered defeat. Their faith and obedience determined their victory. The relationship between faith and obedience and unbelief and disobedience is illustrated at Jericho and then again in Ai.



1 - Jesus in the life of Joshua

1. Both Joshua (Hebrew: Yehoshua) and Jesus (Hebrew: Yeshua) share the same root meaning "Yahweh saves" or "Yahweh is salvation".




2. Joshua instructed Israelites to obey God's law. – Joshua 1:7

Jesus perfectly fulfils the law and instructs all to do so. - Matthew 5:17-20




3. Joshua leads the Israelites into Cannan. - Joshua 3

Jesus leads spiritual Israel into the Heaven. – John 14:3




4. Joshua chose 12 stones one for each tribe. - Joshua 4:1-9

6. Joshua's leads the Israelites to victories over the Canaanites. - Joshua 10:12-14.




Christ's leads spiritual Israel to triumph over sin and death. - Colossians 2:13-15

Jesus will set up His final dwelling with mankind in the new earth. - Revelation 21:3




9. Joshua set up cities of refuge for any who accidentally caused death. – Joshua 20



1. God promised to be with Joshua as they prepare to enter the Cannan. - Joshua 1:5




God promised to be with the believers as they prepare to enter heaven - Matthew 28:20

3. God stopped the waters of the Jordan River so the Israelites could cross over into Cannan. – Joshua 3:16






4. God brought the walls of Jericho down when the Israelites obeyed God and marched 7 times around the city. – Jousha 6:1-5





7. God held the sun still and stayed the moon in the days of Joshua till they won the battle. – Joshua 10:13






8. Caleb at 85 is asking to be in the mountains, ready to fight and drive enemies away. – Joshua 14:10-12

When God gives us clearly marked responsibilities, we should fulfill our duties wholeheartedly. – Ephesians 4:11




10. The tribes of Ephraim and Manasseh demanded more land from Joshua. - Joshua 17:14-18

12. The Israelites had failed to believe God's promise to help them inherit the land. - Joshua 21:43-45








Conclusion


